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PROGRAM OVERVIEW

From 1 July 2024 new laws were introduced that change the rights and protections of workplace delegates.

A workplace delegate is a person appointed by a union to be a representative for union members working in a workplace. They have the right to represent the industrial interests of members and potential members.

These new laws introduce key changes for the awareness of all supervisors, managers and leaders. They include:

- Right of representation;
- Entitlement to reasonable communication;
- Reasonable access to the workplace and workplace facilities; and
- Reasonable access to training.

Ensure all your people leaders and professionals are up to date and able to manage the rights of workplace delegates in this expanded area of Australian employment law.
